Jesus will be our **theme**; his love burning upon the altar of our hearts, will reach the hearts of the people. The **truth** will be presented, not as a cold, lifeless theory, but as **a living force to change the life**. But the **power** is of God through his Holy Spirit, which works effectually on hearts and minds. When Jesus left to his disciples the work which he had begun, he charged them: 'Tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.' And he promised, 'Ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you; and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.' And the disciples 'continued with one accord in prayer and supplication,' waiting for the fulfillment of the promise."
